## Materials and Resources

### Credit 2 Construction Waste Management

Utilize LOOP, Mannington's commercial carpet tile reclamation program, to divert used carpet for your project from landfill. Utilizing the LOOP program will help contribute to MR Credit 2. 1-2 points

### Credit 4 Recycled Content

Mannington Resilient Flooring contains up to 20% post-consumer content and 15% pre-consumer content, helping to earn MR Credit 4. 1-2 points

### Credit 5 Regional Materials

Mannington Hard Surface Flooring may help your project earn points toward MR Credit 5 if the project site is within 500 miles of manufacture and/or extraction. All Mannington Resilient Flooring products are manufactured in Salem, NJ and Hardwood Flooring is manufactured in High Point, NC. Some Resilient Flooring products, such as VCT, are made with limestone (up to 85%) which is extracted from Canaan, CT. 1-2 points

### Credit 6 Rapidly Renewable Materials

Mannington offers flooring made from fast-growing bamboo. 1 point

### Credit 4.1 Low Emitting Materials- Adhesives and Sealants

Mannington Hard Surface Flooring Products use adhesives and sealants that meet the SCAQMD Rule #1168 for VOC limits. Using these adhesives and sealants will contribute to earning IEQ Credit 4.1. 1 point

### Credit 4.3 Low-Emitting Materials- Flooring Systems

### Credit 3 Sustainable Purchasing- Facility Alterations and Additions

Purchasing Mannington Flooring Products may help earn MR Credit 3. Sustainable Purchases are defined by LEED as meeting certain criteria. Mannington's Hard Surface Flooring meets the following criteria recognized by LEED as a Sustainable Purchase: 1 point

 FloorScore Certification

 Recycled Content. Resilient Flooring is available with up to 20% post-consumer content and 15% pre-consumer content. Manufactured in Salem, NJ, helping to earn this credit if the project site is within 500 from Salem, NJ.

VCT is 85% limestone, extracted from Canaan, CT, helping to earn this credit if the project site is within 500 miles of Canaan, CT.

Adhesives and Sealants used with Mannington Resilient Flooring products meet SCAQMD Rule #1168.
